

Focus on lightweight construction | Six-berth over-cab bed model under 3.5t

LMC EXTENDS THE TOURER MODEL RANGE BY ADDING AN OVER-CAB BED

- New Fiat- and Citroen-based Tourer layout A 690 G
- Six berths, gross vehicle weight under 3.5t
- Available to end customers from the summer of 2024 onwards
- Growing interest in hire business all-year-round users benefit from extensive range of standard features

Sassenberg, 08 January 2024 – In the past few years, over-cab bed models have become a niche product (in Europe, 3.4 % share of new vehicle registrations, see CIVD¹); in consequence, many manufacturers have ceased to produce them. However, especially the hire market has shown an increasing interest in multi-berth layouts that can be driven with a B Category driving licence. LMC is exploiting the opportunity this offers; its lightweight construction expertise has made it possible to now present a six-berth overcab bed model that nevertheless has a gross vehicle weight of under 3.5t.

Extension of Tourer model range - focus continues to be on lightweight construction

Another addition with a slightly different silhouette has therefore been made to the recently launched motorhome model range Tourer. The Tourer model range currently features eight layouts for flat and lightweight constructions that were also realised in the over-cab bed model. The sleeping alcove above the cab makes the body considerably higher than that of the Tourer Lift models with drop-down bed options. Due to the retro design scoop on top, its overall height is 3.05 metres.

Attractive and extensive standard features

LMC relies on an extensive range of standard features in order to stand out from comparable models made by competitors. The *Truma Combi 4D* diesel heating system makes the Tourer A 690 G suitable for winter use, and therefore generally an interesting option for all-year-round use. According to the latest gsr + MiiOS study² "Focus Caravaning 2023 (B2C)", the all-year-round use of motorhomes has increased from 65% in 2022 to 67% in 2023. This means that only around every third motorhome is used only part of the year.

Security is firmly embedded in the LMC brand core and has a major influence on the product design. The Tourer's fully GRP enclosed (side walls, floor, roof and rear wall) alcove reflects this, as it guarantees protection in inclement weather. LMC also includes a reversing camera as a standard feature. In addition, the standard version already includes the fifth and sixth seat (not facing in the direction of travel).

Further strong standard feature details are the swivel cab seats, the upholstery fabrics made from 100% recycled PET with "Easy Clean" feature and the rear garage with a 250kg payload, lashing rails, lighting and a 230V socket.
